

# BBC OFFERS BIGGEST ONLINE EDUCATION PUSH 'IN ITS HISTORY'

Starting 20th April, BBC will roll out daily programs to help parents and children with school homework during lockdown. These programs would include videos, quizzes, podcasts and articles. The corporation said every child in the UK would "have their education supported" and it has teamed up with organisations such as the Royal Shakespeare Company, Premier League and Puffin Books to keep the lessons fresh. The initiative will include 14 weeks of core subject learning to offer "rhythm and routine" for pupils. BBC has been offering six 20-minute programmes on air daily on BBC iPlayer and red button, covering core subjects including Maths, English and science, with guidance from experts and teachers. The content will be divided into age groups and BBC Bitesize online will publish a new Maths and English lesson for every child every day with more subjects to follow. Source: BBC

#### EXXONMOBIL SUPPORTS ONLINE EDUCATION WITH \$100,000 FOR CARLSBAD MUNICIPAL SCHOOLS

The Carlsbad Municipal School District is receiving \$100,000 from ExxonMobil to support online education in response to unprecedented circumstances associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. Funding will help provide technology and internet connectivity to low income students who are living in remote locations with limited access to the internet. ExxonMobil is also responding to the COVID-19 pandemic by maximizing production of products such as isopropyl alcohol, a key ingredient in hand sanitizer, and polypropylene, which is used for making protective equipment for health care workers and first responders. The company is also working with the Global Center for Medical Innovation to design and support the manufacturing of reusable shields and masks for health care workers. In 2018, ExxonMobil contributed nearly \$35 million to higher education, medical care, environmental research and arts and civic organizations in Texas and New Mexico.. Source: Business Wire
