## UK EDUCATION TECH FIRM EXPANDS ONLINE COURSES IN INDIA

A UK-based education technology company has announced plans to expand its online courses available across international schools in India from September. Pamoja said it will offer a range of new online "Cambridge IGCSE" and "Cambridge International AS & A Level" courses to Cambridge International Schools throughout India covering science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) subjects. These courses are being launched the same time the Indian government is seeking to train up over 40 crore people in different disciplines by 2022 through its Skill India campaign, launched in 2015. The importance of STEM learning as part of this was underscored by a recent report by the National Science Foundation that found that 80 per cent of the jobs created in India in the next decade will require some form of maths and science skills. **Source: Hindustan Times** 

# FORMER APPLE TECH-EDUCATION PROPERTY LAUNCHES DATA ANALYSIS TOOLS

A tech-education company once owned by Apple Inc. AAPL, -0.59% on Thursday said it is launching new data analysis tools for millions of educators using its distance learning platform. With the learning gap growing as school closures continue because of the COVID-19 pandemic, data visualization will help educators identify and address gaps with personalized learning and resources, according to PowerSchool, which was part of Apple from 2001 to 2006. An estimated \$8 trillion will be spent worldwide on education by 2025, with much of the growth in EdTech fueled by artificial intelligence. The number of students logging onto online classes has declined 43% since the start of remote learning, while the amount of students completing at least one virtual lesson decreased 44%, according to an Achieve3000 report.
